Congratulations on your decision to invest in a solid timber bench top from The Woodsmiths. This bench top has been lovingly handcrafted especially for you, to our high-quality standard. We do ask you to read and implement the care and cleaning instructions, so your investment is protected, and your warranty is kept valid.

Installation

It is very important that installation is carried out according to instructions provided. If this is not the case, the warranty will not stand.

Care & Cleaning Instructions

This bench top is totally sealed with a specially formulated hard wearing Generation 4 finish. Please note this finish may not have fully cured yet, which means it is still hardening. Extra care will be needed over the first month of use not to mark the surface. Use coasters for tea & coffee cups and anything hot (boiling water will not mark surface).

- Clean top with any non-abrasive household cleaner & microfibre cloth.
- To polish bench top, apply 'teak wax' supplied sparingly with soft cloth. Leave 10 minutes, then buff top with clean cloth. More wax can be purchased off our website when required (see link below).
- Fine steel wool and methylated spirits can be used to remove any heavy build-up of wax & grime.
- Do not subject bench top to any concentrated heat; e.g. hot pots and pans, direct sunlight. Place mats, tiles, glass or marble should be used in areas where hot pots and pans are used frequently.
- Generation 4 finish is totally waterproof and impervious to household substances such as caustic soda, beetroot juice, bleaches & colour concentrates. Wipe up with damp cloth & re-wax if necessary.
- Solid timber is a natural product; a small amount of movement is normal and acceptable
